IRHA/IRHBA/NRHA DERBY PRESENTED BY DENIRO BOOT CO. CORTESI AND JULY JOE SNAP SNATCH TOP HONORS

Emotions ran high on Saturday night in Cremona, Italy, where the 2024 IRHA/IRHBA/NRHA Derby concluded with the DeNiroBootCo Open Derby Finals.

The last three riders to go determined who would hold the first three positions and, last in the draw with a 230.5 to beat, Manuel Cortesi and his faithful companion July Joe Snap continued their winning streak by posting a 231 to win both the IRHA/IRHBA and IRHA Level (L)4 Open Championships.

Level 4 Open

"What can I say? There was a 230.5 to beat so it was the toughest run ever with 'Joe,'" said Cortesi who claimed the IRHA Futurity, NRHA Euro Futurity, NRHA Germany 4-year-old and IRHA 4-year-old Futurity Championships with the talented stallion between the reins. "I've never had such a high score to beat, but we ran in and both gave everything we had. As always, the horse didn't disappoint; he's truly incredible! I think he is the best and strongest horse in the history of European reining. Now the plan is to let him rest a bit, show

him a few times without putting pressure on, and then with the owners we will decide whether to show him at the 100X. The emotion of being able to say that you have won everything with the same horse is incredible, it's a lifelong dream come true." The chestnut stallion by Master Snapper - the only European bred horse to have won the NRHA Open Derby - out of San July Jo Magnetic is owned by Arcese/Cuoghi and was bred by Cuoghi/Ronchi.

Only a half point behind, France's Arnaud Girinon had to settle for the IRHA/ IRHBA and IRHA L4 Reserve Championships following a powerful ride aboard Anna Maria Scheiflinger's flashy palomino stallion Flexing Guns N Town (NRHA Three Million Dollar Sire Hollywoodstinseltown x Shesa Fashion Gun) bred by Peter Morgan. "I'm very happy; my horse showed off what he really is capable of. Until tonight I never managed to have a flawless run, even though I did make a little

mistake entering the right spin. He truly gave me everything and was amazing. I've been riding him since 2023, when Gennaro [Lendi] moved to the States and I took over the reins. I showed him at the 4-year-old Futurity last year and he did very well there too. Now our next show will be the 100X and then the NRHA European Derby."

Level 3 Open

By marking an impressive 223.5 in the first section of the Open Finals, Tiara Van Dongen and Orangeisthenublack (NRHA Eight Million Dollar Sire Smart Spook x NRHA Million Dollar Dam Ebony Shines), a 6-year-old mare



owned and bred by Gisela Haas, claimed both the IRHA/IRHBA and IRHA L3 Open Championships. "I've been showing 'Orange' since she was 4 years old and we already had some good results but this title feels great! I love this horse; she's the clown of the barn and is the 'typical mare.' She can seem kind of freaky but if you become friends with her, she really loves you, and if she doesn't like you...she will let you know!" said the Dutch rider who was thrilled with her win. "We're planning to bring her to the 100X and to the [NRHA] European Derby at the end of the year. In between we're going to do some schooling shows."

Level 2 Open

Cristian Dalla Pozza and Jerry Show Step (My Showbiz Whiz x Wimpys Surprised Chex), an 8-year-old stallion bred and owned by Ambrosini Quarter Horses, had already tied to win the L2 qualifier. The pair came back strong in the first section of the Finals scoring a 221 to take home both the IRHBA and IRHA L2 Open Championships. "I'm obviously very happy with today's result; my horse was great the whole week here in Cremona and even if sometimes in the show pen he's not that easy, tonight he was really super," said the Italian trainer. "I've been riding him since I moved to Ambrosini QH and we went on to win other smaller shows. At home he's easy to manage and our youth riders ride him quite often. Last year, at the World Youth Reining Cup, he brought home the gold medal [with Brazil's Astrid Annas in the saddle]. A huge thank you goes to the entire Ambrosini



Level 1 Open

Once the first section was over, the winners of the IRHA/IRHBA and IRHA L1 Open Derby were determined after posting a 220: Alessandra Ischia and Xtra Pistolforwimpy, an 8-year-old stallion by NRHA Thirteen Million Dollar Sire Wimpys Little Step out of Ruf Pistol, owned by Indal Srl, and bred by Smart Like Juice Inc. The pair, winners of the L1 qualifier, also took reserve honors in the

L2 division. "I've been riding this horse since I went to work for [NRHA Professional] Davide Brighenti about a year and a half ago. He is owned by Vittorio Legati who has always shown him in Non Pro competition. Last year he let me show him at the Sliding Before Christmas show in Veneto where we claimed the Reserve Championship with a 220 score. The initial plan was for his owner to show him here, then - if I may say so - luckily for me, the last minute decision was that I would ride him. This horse has a heart of gold, he doesn't need any particular management, is always very good and always gives his best in the show pen. I really want to thank Davide

[Brighenti] who's making me grow a lot, is giving me a lot of opportunities, and always helps me - even during this busy week."

The Quarter Dream Non Pro Finals End With a Bang!

Friday action in Cremona, Italy, was focused on the Quarter Dream \$57,350-added IRHA/IRHBA/ NRHA and \$48,000-added IRHA/NRHA Non Pro Derby Finals where 52 combinations battled for the titles. Who would take home the Level (L)4, 3, and 2 Championships was left to the last three riders who shone under the CremonaFiere lights: Elena Kompatscher, Carlo Ambrosini, and Bo Brutsaert.

Level 4 & Level 3 Non Pro

Elena Kompatscher and Monster Made (NRHA Two Million Dollar Sire Inferno Sixty Six x Madeof Pure Spangled), a 5-year-old stallion owned by Jacopo Rossi and bred by Cardinal Hill Training Center LLC., stole the show scoring a 221.5 to win the IRHA/IRHBA/

NRHA L4 Non Pro Championship, the IRHA/ NRHA L4 Non Pro Reserve Championship, and both the IRHA/IRHBA and IRHA L3 titles. "I am thrilled with my horse tonight and still cannot believe all this is true," said the young Italian rider hot off her win. "We purchased him when he was 3, right before the IRHA Futurity where I showed him and took reserve honors in the L3 Non Pro division. We've always believed in him and he was great under the guidance of my father [NRHA Professional Alois Kompatscher], but we always felt there was something missing. We passed the reins to [NRHA Professional] Manuel Cortesi, we


clicked, and the results prove he is the great horse we always thought he was."

Carlo Ambrosini and BMS Walla Getcha Gun (Walla Whiz Crome x Ally Get Your Gun), an 8-year-old stallion bred by Barbara Seibold and owned by Ambrosini QH, closed the night with a powerful and precise run paid back by the judges with a 225.5 crowning them IRHA/NRHA L4 Champions. "What an emotion: He's an incredible horse! He was always there for me during the entire run and we managed to perform all credit maneuvers, I'm really really happy. I was a little nervous before entering

the finals, but I was sure I could trust my mount, I knew I was the one who didn't have to make mistakes. I want to thank all my team, Giuseppe Prevosti, Christian Dalla Pozza, Fabio Alfonsetti and my family; without them none of this would be possible."

Level 2 Non Pro

Posting a 217.5, Bo Brutsaert and KB CJ Gun (CJ Whiz x KB Jenny Whiz A Gun), an 8-year-old mare owned and bred by her father, Koen Brutsaert, performed to win both the IRHA/IRHBA and IRHA/NRHA L2 Non Pro Championships. "This is my 'Rachel,' and I was really looking forward to tonight; as always she did super well, and always shows the same way," said the Belgian rider. "She's by my own stallion, I bred her mother who was also bred by us and this is the best thing that could happen. She's also had babies and I am really looking forward to riding them. I train with Kim Obenhaus and my mare alternates between



Level 1 Non Pro

Taking home the IRHA/NRHA L1 Championship with a 214.5 score was Francesca Giulia Solbiati riding SM Five B Ice (Chic Magnetic x Iceinside), a 7-year-old mare bred and owned by Massimo Solbiati.

"She's a mare that I have always known, as she's home-bred, and my dad is the owner of the mare she's out of. I am very happy because the goal was to make the finals, and being able to win the Level 1 was certainly

beyond my expectations. I ride with Fabio Alfonsetti, with the help of Giuseppe Prevosti, and I would like to thank them both as well as the whole Ambrosini QH team."

With a 213.5 score, claiming the IRHA/IRHBA/ NRHA L1 division, was youth rider Marco Paolacci riding Business Whiz RM (Spark N Whiz x Dunnit With Cash), a 6-year-old gelding owned by his father Mauro Paolacci and bred by Massimo Rudari. "I've had this horse for a year now and this is the second important win in my career, and the most important one. I'd like to thank my coach, Alessandro Meconi; together we work in a

very professional manner. I would also like to thank mv mother and father, my number one fans and sponsors, and look forward to showing my horse in the special events coming up this year and will try to do my best with him."





WIMPYS LITTLE CHIC BECOMES FIRST NRHA TWO MILLION DOLLAR DAM

In March 2024, a historic reining milestone was passed as Wimpys Little Chic became the first National Reining Horse Association Two Million Dollar Dam. This singular achievement is further proof of her legendary status within the reining industry.

Wimpys Little Chic, owned by NRHA Hall of Famer Arcese Quarter Horses USA, stands as a paragon of excellence in the realm of reining, consistently showcasing unparalleled talent and grace in the arena with NRHA Hall of Famer Shawn Flarida at the reins. The pair are the only team in reining history to win the NRHA Futurity, NRHA Derby, and the National Reining Breeders Classic consecutively. Together, they have garnered more than \$516,000 in NRHA lifetime earnings.

"Wimpys Little Chic
is simply the greatest
reining horse to ever draw a breath," said
Flarida. "I have asked [my wife] Michele to write
a book about our journey in this life together.
She said the chapter on Wimpys Little Chic or
'Lexi' would be entitled, 'A Love Story.""

Bred by Double Run Farm, Wimpys Little Chic is by NRHA \$13 Million Sire Wimpys Little Step, and out of Double Run Farm's great broodmare Collena Chic Olena.

With a lineage steeped in greatness,

redefined the standards of excellence within the reining community. Although the reining community mourned the loss of Wimpy's Little Chic last October, her legacy continues through her descendants.

Through her offspring, Lexi has significantly impacted the sport, elevating the expectations of reining enthusiasts worldwide. Her progeny have consistently demonstrated exceptional talent and athleticism, earning acclaim and

accolades at the most elite reining events worldwide.

At the American Performance Horseman (TAPH), presented by Teton Ridge, she was the dam of two of the five reining horses competing: All Bettss Are Off and Finals Bound. The reining champion, Down Right Amazing, is out of a daughter of Wimpys Little Chic, 2015 NRHA Futurity Champion Shesouttayourleague.

DAN HUSS - PREPARING NON PROS AT HOME

NRHA Professional Dan Huss's career spans over 30 years, beginning at Findlay College in Ohio. After graduating, Huss remained at the University and taught equestrian studies for almost 20 years. He implemented the training and teaching processes he developed at Findlay into a successful program for himself and for the numerous top-level Non Pros he has coached.



Dan's lifetime earnings exceed \$718,600 through multiple titles at the All-American Quarter Horse Congress, a top 10 finish at the 2021 NRHA Open Futurity, multiple finalist finishes at every major event, and many other accolades.

Known for his attention to detail, Huss translates that focus into a step-by-step teaching process that promotes consistency and mental compartmentalizing of each maneuver into those that he teaches, including his four-legged students.

A Dream Team Sometimes Faith Trumps Statistics

My dear readers, please forgive me for not writing to you sooner. I was traveling, I was packing, I was unpacking, I was cleaning, I was taking care of 4 children and Casey, I was working on invoices, I was paying bills...

The truth is, I was putting off what should've been written long ago. Ideas, prayers, and words have flooded my mind after so many incredible victories ... in the middle of the night or while I am jogging down the road early in the morning....

Cheryl Cody asked if I would be interested in writing a "lifestyle" column for WorldWide Slide. That means current events, recipes, fashion, family, faith, and horse life. Writing to you is an honor and a privilege, so it begins. This year I will take action and write, not just smother fresh ideas because I fear rejection or criticism. It is very tempting to write this Lifestyle Column as an anonymous Cowgirl from Texas; however, after all, we have been through in recent years, what a shame for me not to show enough gratitude or share a true testimonial about a life-changing experience that God has allowed.

Why should I concern myself with the possibility of mockery, hateful criticism, or negative comments from a few when I could encourage, inspire, or perhaps ignite a fire to great change?

I have been reminded to stay on the mission. In this column, I want to talk to you about how faith can trump statistics, and the importance of teamwork.

There is a horse that is a huge part of our lives, our team, and our family; he has been capturing the hearts and eyes of many people in the horse industry since the 2024 American

Performance Horseman held in the iconic Globe Life Field. This is a horse that when my husband, Casey Deary, is interviewed, he refers to him as a soldier, our steady rock, and he is Down Right Amazing, bred by Rob Curtis and currently owned by DAG Ventures LLC. This horse, more affectionately known as "Amazing," patiently waited for his time in the spotlight as a three- and four-year-old, then he took the reining world by force in the fall of 2022.

His first victory was the 2022 Run For A Million Shootout Qualifier, his second victory was the 2023 American Performance Horseman Reining Championship.

Many people recommended Down Right Amazing stop competing after he won the 2023 American Performance Horseman Reining Championship, but his career was meant to continue, despite what statistics say about other reining stallions. His third victory was the 2023 National Reining Breeders Classic, his fourth was the 2023 National Reining Horse Association Derby, and his fifth was the 2024 American Performance Horseman Reining Championship.

Sometimes faith trumps statistics. Behind every victory is a battle beforehand, seen or not seen, internal or external. There was a war

before we broke through to our great purpose. I have seen this pattern many times in my life, so, I want to encourage you all to stay on your mission.

When Casey was young and beginning to ride horses at age 15, he was criticized and told he would not be successful or competitive in the reining horse industry. He suffered a life-threatening horse injury at age 16, and again was told to quit. He persevered, healed, learned, prayed, and pursued his calling of being a reining horse trainer with faith in God.

Again, sometimes faith trumps statistics.

On Saturday December 3, 2011, Casey and I went to breakfast with our client, whose horse did not make the NRHA Open Futurity finals, he wanted to express his opinions on our horse business, and he looked at Casey and told him, "You are a good non pro coach and businessman, but you will never make it as an open trainer. You will never be able to compete at the top level with the Champions."

We listened, shook hands, and parted ways respectfully. Casey and I got in the truck with our children, Wyatt who was six and Owen who was three, and I was seven months pregnant with Julia Joy. We parked and hurried into the prestigious NRHA 2-Year-Old Futurity Prospect Sale.

We had studied, watched, and prayed about a 2-year-old Gunner filly that was deaf and had a big bald face and large ears. She was special to us, and after she appeared to be sold, I grabbed Casey's arm after and I squeezed him tight.... I said, "Casey Deary you do whatever it takes! Go talk to that man and buy that horse!"

Dana Conrad partnered with us on that mare whose name was Dun It With My Gun. We later put our heads together and renamed her Americasnextgunmodel. Exactly one year later, Casey won his first NRHA Open Futurity Championship, and our lives were forever changed.

Sometimes faith trumps statistics.

The American Performance Horseman launched the tea, concept for the horse

world. The "Team" concept at TAPH may seem new to the horse industry since most of our events are one-horse and one-rider situations. However, in our house and on our ranch, we talk about the team concept a lot. Our sons, now 18 and 16, play team sports in addition to riding horses. We have witnessed some incredible motivational speeches from several great coaches. I have observed many teams that have bonded together and fought harder for a victory when they should've been defeated statistically. There are dozens of true-story award-winning movies on this exact matter.

On the contrary, I have also seen teams and barns with conflict, individual selfish demands, and hatred towards one another. This results in failure many times, even though the talent is world-class.

When your lifestyle involves setting goals for your team and you personally, when you have a reason for success that is bigger than only you, your chances for success are far greater.

Traditionally, in January, most people, the media, motivational speakers, and others encourage goal setting. My parents always told my brother, sister, and me to write our goals down. We ate black-eyed peas and had a nice meal on New Year's Day; we usually had a simple discussion on goals for each family member. As an adult, I tell my children the same thing, yet now I understand the method and reason or purpose of goal setting a little deeper.

In a published article from the Harvard University Business School dated 1979. Harvard conducted a study on goal setting and analyzed a graduating class to determine how many had set goals and had a plan for their attainment. The graduating class was asked a single question about their goals in life. The question was this, "Have you set written goals and created a plan for their attainment?"

Before graduation, it was determined that: 84% of the entire class had set no goals at all 13% of the class had set written goals but had no concrete plans

3% of the class had both written goals and

set no goals at all.

However, the 3% of the class that had both written goals and a plan, were making 10 times as much as the rest of the class. There is a strategy for setting goals the right way.

#1 — Set a Highly-Specific Goal

#2 — Create Strong-Enough Reasons

#3 — Develop a Thorough Plan

#4 — Take Massive Action

#5 — Manage, Track and Adjust

In closing, I appreciate the soldier analogy for Down Right Amazing more and more as time passes. A great soldier serves others; he fights for his team, his family, and his country, and he wants to win for a great cause. In my opinion, a selfish soldier would be shameful and not useful, perhaps a traitor. A soldier does not aspire to be the best on the team. A soldier aspires to be the best for the team and for his/ her country. The soldier analogy inspires me and motivates me. Ask yourself, do you want to be a blessing? Or do you just want to be blessed? Are you willing to feed other people? Or do you just want to be fed?




